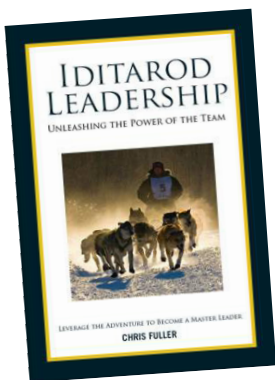


About Chris
